- 1. When we encounter poverty (homeless person, panhandler, etc.), what are some ways we can help without enabling destructive behavior?
- 2. Read Leviticus 19:9-10 and Isaiah 3:14-15. Describe God's vision for how society ought to interact with the poor.
- 3. The poor and powerless matter to God. Expand that truth beyond financial poverty. How can we understand our soul's condition as impoverished and needy?
- 4. What would it look like to give to the needy in secret? By contrast, what would it look like to "announce it with trumpets" in our modern context?
- 5. Define "hypocrite" in v. 2. How do we know if we're acting like a hypocrite? How can we avoid it?
- 6. What does Jesus mean when he says, "Do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing" in v. 3? How do we do that?
- 7. Read Matthew 25:31-46. How does this passage flesh out the concept of "rewards"? Who is the ultimate recipient of our generosity?
- 8. Has God placed a person or charitable organization on your heart in response to this message?
