- 2. Read Jonah 1:17. How did Jonah find himself in this situation. What did the Lord do in response? Why do you think the Lord left Jonah in the fish's belly for so long?
- 3. Read Psalm 139. How might this Psalm have influenced Jonah during his time in the belly of the fish?
- 4. Read Jonah 2:1–6a. How does Jonah's situation bring clarity to the condition of his heart? How does it provoke him to respond? Why do you think God desired this for Jonah?
- 5. Read Psalm 130. What parallels exist between Jonah's situation and the composer of this Psalm?
- 6. Read Jonah 2:6b–10. How does the Lord's deliverance demonstrate his grace?
- 7. How does irony manifest in Jonah's psalm when considered within the context of the whole book?
- 8. How does Jonah's response in v9 reflect the response of the sailors in chapter 1?
- 9. In what ways is God calling you to respond to what you can't control today?
